What's new?

State of charge visibility

Drivers and operators can now view a vehicle's state of charge (SoC) throughout a charging session in the app, including the starting charge level and how it increases over time. This feature is available for most DC chargers. SoC data will also be shared with roaming partners to enhance their drivers' charging experience.

Why it matters

- Drivers can see their charging progress more clearly
- Operators gain richer data for reporting and energy analysis

 More visibility, smarter charging decisions and greater transparency around the state of charge for drivers.

Smoother site setup

Creating new sites is now simpler and faster for operators adding their charging sites to the Fuuse Platform.

- Address lookup is now easier to use
- The default country auto-fills from your organisation's location

Better network transparency

Operator branding is now shown for Gireve-connected networks, helping you and your drivers see which partners power your roaming sessions.

 More clarity across the Fuuse-powered charging network.

- Fixed scrolling on smaller screens during the onboarding process
- Improved sorting and display for promotions and messages
